## **Open Access and Triage**

The Open Access Team offer assessment and care planned entry into and through substance misuse and alcohol services in Calderdale for people aged 21 and over who are experiencing problems with drugs or alcohol.

### **We Provide:**

- Needle Exchange
- Harm reduction advice
- Comprehensive assessment and referral to appropriate treatment
- Hepatitis C testing and vaccination against Hep A and B
- A named key worker to offer one to one support for stimulant, cannabis and steroid use
- One to one support with a named key worker to provide support for people with mild to moderate alcohol problems
- Assessment and referral on to other services where appropriate
- Direct referral for clinical services such as substitute prescribing
- Referral on to Calderdale Alcohol Team (CAT) for those in need of help around severe alcohol problems (Can not stop drinking without experiencing withdrawal symptoms)
- Advice and information to users, families and other professionals

12:30pm to 5pm and  
Thursdays 9am to 7pm
